WHY STUDY FINANCIAL LITERACY EDUCATION?

Financial Literacy Education is a great way to enhance any community service role or to move into financial literacy education roles. This course provides a set of skills detailing the provision of basic financial literacy education to be used with clients and is not financial counselling.

For those working in AOD, DFV, Custodial, Homelessness, Parenting, NDIS, Aged Care Programs and any program that deals with vulnerable and excluded clients, this information will improve your program outcomes exponentially.

Financial Literacy Education workers provide direct client support and group education about financial literacy and assist in financial wellbeing.

WHAT ARE THE OUTCOMES?

Successful completion of the Financial Literacy Education course assists the participant to gain the skills and knowledge required to apply these skills in financial capability and financial literacy education roles. Reducing recidivism, homelessness, addiction, isolation, vulnerability and hopelessness within our community has a direct correlation to a sound understanding of the effects of low/no financial literacy among our clients.

Community Services workers will enhance their skills and provide a more holistic approach that impacts the lives of their clients.

STUDENTS WILL LEARN HOW TO:

- Understand their own money story and how that influences the way they work with clients
- Inform others of important financial facts and rights
- Understand the financial challenges of individuals
- Apply client centred practices
- Identify financial needs of people from specific demographics
- Refer clients to other services including financial counselling

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no course prerequisite qualifications, however students are required to demonstrate literacy and numeracy skills in line with Certificate IV level studies. Students must be able to commit to two hours of personal study time in addition to class time. Applicants should have interest and/or relevant experience in the social and community services field and have the appropriate maturity and interpersonal skills to work with a diverse range of people.

Students must also have good computer skills.

DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

This course is delivered both in person over two days, and online at your own pace. All deliveries include assessment and certification.

COURSE FEES
